## Professional Services

Our centre is a purposeful therapeutic environment where we conduct animal assisted therapy- specifically working with well trained dogs. Each participant is an individual with personal goals and those goals form the basis of our goal directed therapeutic process to improve independence, agency and life skills.

Our therapeutic team consist of the participant, practitioner, and the dog. Our focus is to improve social, psychological and cognitive abilities of our participant.

Dogs have a great ability to mirror a participant's emotions and behaviours providing immediate feedback for both the participant and practitioner, creating opportunities for growth and change.
