The training of a Diabetic Alert Dog requires a broad collection of viable scent samples, of low blood glucose readings. The non-invasive collection procedures require the Diabetic donor to take a gauze swab of sweat while they are experiencing a low reading of 3.5 mmol/L or less, and place in the jars provided. These scent samples are then donated to Righteous Pups, to ensure the on-going training of Diabetic Alert Dogs for Australians living with Type-1 Diabetes.

Trained through a tested and proven scientific process, the dogs powerful nose can detect a dangerous low up to 10 minutes before a pump can register the same low! Plus, the dog's nose is never off-duty!
